Applications are invited online only by One Time Registration exclusively from qualified candidates belonging to the following communities of Kerala State for appointment in the under mentioned post in District Co-operative Banks in Idukki, Palakkad, Thiruvananthapuram and Kottayam. - (i) Candidates should apply through online application by One Time Registration provided in the Kerala Public Service Commission website www.keralapsc.gov.in. Conventional type of application for the above post will be summarily rejected.
- (ii) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the community other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to such candidates.
- (iii) The Selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a district wise basis and Ranked List will be prepared for concerned District Co-operative Bank. The Ranked List thus prepared and published as per this notification shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the NCA turn identified as unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following date in the following district.

- (iv) The candidates shall submit application for the post in any one of the

District Co-operative Banks mentioned above where the vacancy is existing for the respective community and shall note the name of that district against the relevant column in the application.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment from the eligible candidates belonging to the SC and OBC Community.
6. Age : 1) For SC Candidates:- 18-45. Only candidates born between 2.1.1972 and 1.1.1999 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. (including the relaxation as per Para 2 (1) of the General condition).
2) For OBC Candidates:- 18-43. Only candidates born between 2.1.1974 and 1.1.1999 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. (including the relaxation as per Para 2 (1) of the General condition.)

Note:-

For conditions allowed in upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years, [please see para (2) of the General Conditions under Part II of this Notification]. Relaxation of age will be allowed to all provisional employees of the Twenty Nine Co-operative Institutions mentioned in G.O.(P) No.41/98 dated 09.03.1998 (whether they continue in service or relieved from service) who have been appointed through the Employment Exchange to the extent of their provisional service provided they possess a minimum service of One year in the provisional appointment. The maximum period of relaxation allowed to such persons will be five years. Once they get appointment on regular basis, the concession will not be available to further appointment to any post. The candidates who are entitled to the above concession shall note the details thereof in the respective columns of the applications and submit a certificate (Original) obtained from the Head of Office or Head of Department or appointing authority of the Co-operative Institutions concerned, when the Commission called for. The Certificate should contain all the relevant particulars such as the post in which the applicant has/had provisional service, the scale of pay, name of the Co-operative Institutions in which he/she has/had worked, the date of commencement of Provisional Service and the date of termination of the Provisional Service. It should also be noted in the Certificate that the applicant is not holding regular appointment under the Co-operative Institutions. The Original Certificate thus produced will not be returned to the candidates.

7. Qualifications:-

- 1 Pass in Standard VII and should not acquired any degree. In the absence of candidates having the above qualification those who have the qualification as per the parent notification ie “Pass in Standard VII” will be considered for selection to this post.

Note:- KS & SSR Part II Rule 10 a (ii) is applicable for selection to this post.

8 Mode of submitting applications:-

Candidates must register as per “ONE TIME REGISTRATION” with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission, viz, 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging in to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken after 31/12/2010. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed at the bottom portion. The photograph

once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link Registration Card in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile, candidates must ensure the correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote their User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The Application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove Qualification, experience, Community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for. **Candidates who have Aadhar Card should add Aadhar Card as ID proof in their profile.**

11. Sub Paras 5,8,9,10, 11, 12,13 in Para 2 and para 7 of the General Conditions are not applicable to this post.

If a Written Test/OMR/Online Test is conducted as a part of this selection, Admission Ticket for eligible candidates will be made available in their Profile for One Time Registration and the date of downloading will be included in the Examination Calendar. Candidates can download Admission Ticket for 15 days from this date. Candidates who have downloaded the Admission Ticket will alone be permitted to attend the examination.
