- (i) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to these candidates.
- (ii) Ranked list will be prepared for Thrissur unit in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above community, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following dates in the following unit as detailed below

(iii) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on unit basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O. (MS) No 92/80/Home dated, 24.09.1980. A candidate advised for appointment in one unit from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another unit unless he completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former unit. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O(MS)No.4/61/PD dated 02.1.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one unit are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

6.	Age	:	Viswakarma: 18-39. Candidates born between 2.1.1977 and 1.1.1998 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. (Including age relaxation specified in Para 2 (i) of the General Conditions)

- 7. Qualifications:
- (1) Pass in SSLC or its equivalent examination. Rule 10 (a) (ii) of KS & SSR is applicable.
- (2) (i) Must possess physical fitness as specified below:-Must have at least 165 cm height and must be 81.3 cms round the chest on full exhalation and must have chest expansion of at least 5 cms.

Note:

- (a) Other qualifications being equal, the Home guard Volunteers who have completed the term of 3 years in that organisation and who have undergone training during the period of tenure satisfactorily, will be treated as having additional or desirable qualification.
- (b) Proficiency in Sports, Military Training and Membership in National Cadets Corps will be considered as additional qualification.

(2) (ii) Physical Efficiency Test :-

Candidates will be subjected to a Physical Efficiency Test and must qualify themselves in the following events namely:-

Note:

The physical measurement of candidates will be taken at the time of physical efficiency test and those who do not possess the prescribed physical measurement will not be admitted for the physical efficiency test. If accidents or injuries happen to a candidate while participating in the physical Efficiency Test, he will not be given further chance to participate in the test.

3. <u>Visual Standards</u>: All candidates must possess the visual standards specified below without glasses

- (c) Each eye must have full field of vision. Colour blindness, squint or any other morbid condition of the eyes or lids of either eye will be deemed to be a disqualification
- (d) Must be free from apparent physical defects like knock knee, Flat Foot, Varicose veins, Bow Legs, Deformed limbs, Irregular and Protruding Teeth, Defective Speech and Hearing
- **Note:** Candidates should produce at the time of Physical Efficiency Test a Medical Certificate in original in the form prescribed here under certifying to their physical fitness and eye sight without glasses. The Medical Certificate should

be one obtained from a Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant surgeon/Junior consultant in Government Service and upload the same in their profile at the time of verification of certificates.

Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link Registration Card in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission.
