- 8 years experience in Engineering profession of which atleast 3 years should be teaching experience in the subject as Lecturer not below Diploma Level in recognised/approved Institution.

- 2. Diploma in Computer Engineering/Technology obtained after undergoing a regular course of study for not less than 3 years with 60% marks in the qualifying examinations and a pass in section A and B of AMIE will be considered as equivalent to Degree in Computer Engineering/Technology.
- 3. In the case of First or Second Class Post Graduate Degree holders in Computer Engineering/Technology, the prescribed 60% marks in the concerned branch for the basic degree will not be insisted upon
