NOTIFICATION

Special Recruitment for PH (Low Vision, Hearing Impairment & Locomotor Disability/Cerebral Palsy) for filling up of backlog vacancies during 2004-07

(State wide)

Applications are invited online only by **ONE TIME REGISTRATION** from qualified candidates belonging to Physically Handicapped (Low Vision, Hearing Impairment & Locomotor Disability/Cerebral Palsy) category in the State of Kerala for the following post.

- 1. Department** : Public Works
- 2. Name of Post** : II Grade Overseer/Draftsman (Civil)
- 3. Scale of Pay** : ₹ 11620-20240/-
- 4. Number of vacancies** : 5(Five) Backlog vacancies
(Low vision – 2
Hearing Impairment – 2
Locomotor Disability/Cerebral Palsy – 1)

The Ranked List prepared in pursuance of this notification is intended to make recruitment to the backlog vacancies earmarked for the various categories and PH groups as per GO (P) No 7/2011/SWD dated 24/01/2011 and will remain in force for a maximum period of three years subject to the condition that the ranked list will cease to exist as and when candidates are advised and appointed against the above mentioned vacancies. Rules 14 to 17 of Part II, KS&SSR are not applicable to this selection.

Candidates will be advised and appointed against the above mentioned vacancies and also against the backlog vacancies, if any, reported by the Appointing Authorities as earmarked in GO(P) No 7/2011/SWD dated 24/01/2011.

Selection to the above-mentioned vacancies will be made from among the (Low Vision, Hearing Impairment & Locomotor Disability/Cerebral Palsy) PH categories found suitable for the post as per existing government orders and vacancies will be apportioned among these categories in the ratio 1:1:1.

- 5. Method of appointment** : **Direct Recruitment from among the PH** (Low Vision, Hearing Impairment & Locomotor Disability/Cerebral Palsy) candidates only.

Note:- Applications submitted by candidates other than those belonging to PH (Low Vision, Hearing Impairment & Locomotor Disability/Cerebral Palsy) category will be rejected. Individual rejection memo will not be sent to them.

6. Age limit

: 1. Hearing Impairment and Low Vision candidates:- 18 – 50; Only candidates born between 01.01.1997 and 02.01.1965 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for the post.

2. Locomotor Disability/Cerebral Palsy candidates 18 – 46. Only candidates born between 01.01.1997 and 02.01.1969 (both dates included) are eligible for this post.

7. Qualifications:- Should possess any one of the following qualifications.

(a) Group Certificate under KGTE or equivalent Examinations.

Note:- Group Certificates will include all the four groups viz. Building Drawing, Building Construction, Survey and Irrigation.

OR

A pass in eight subjects, namely,

- i) Surveying and Leveling (Higher)
- ii) Applied Mechanics (Higher)
- iii) Building Material and Construction (Higher)
- iv) Hydraulics and Irrigation (Higher)
- v) Building Drawing and Estimating (Higher)
- vi) Earth Work and Road Making (Higher)
- vii) Geometrical Drawing (Lower) or Practical Plane and Solid Geometry (Lower)
- viii) Mensuration (Lower)

b) Diploma in Craftsmanship in the trade of 'Draftsman (Civil)' or 'Surveyor' obtained after 18 months course (followed by 6 months practical training) at the Industrial Training Institutes/Centres conducted by the Government of India, Ministry of Labour.

Note:-1) Candidates who have successfully completed the Industrial Training of 18 months will also be treated as qualified even if they have not completed the period of practical training. But their appointments will be treated as provisional and will be regularised only after the completion of six months practical training.

2) Diploma in Craftsmanship (Trade Test Certificate) in the Trade of Draftsman (Civil) awarded to private candidates without insisting on six months practical training will be treated as an alternative qualification for direct recruitment to the post of II Grade Draftsman.

c) Diploma in Civil Engineering (2 year course) of the Women's Polytechnic of the State.

Note:- Rule 10 (a)(ii) of Part II, KS & SSR is applicable.

8. **Mode of submitting Application:-** Before applying for the post, candidates shall register as per “ONE TIME REGISTRATION” with the official website of Kerala Public Service Commission ‘www.keralapsc.gov.in’. Those who have registered shall apply by logging in to their profile using their User-Id and Password. No application fee is required. Candidates can view, rectify defects and have printouts of the details on the registration card by clicking the link ‘Registration card’ after entering the home page. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password and they shall quote the user ID for further communication with the Commission. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the provisions of Notification and the instructions given in the Website will be summarily rejected. Documents to prove qualification, age, community etc have to be produced as and when called for.
