Applications are invited Online only by “ONE TIME REGISTRATION” from qualified candidates belonging to Latin Catholic /Anglo Indian community in the State of Kerala for selection to the under mentioned post in Kerala Government service.

1. **Department** : **Collegiate Education**
2. **Name of Post** : **Lecturer in Law**
3. **Scale of pay** : **U.G.C Scale**
4. **Number of vacancies** : **Latin Catholic /Anglo Indian – 1 (One)**

**Note:-** The above vacancy is now in existence. The Ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked to the above community but remain unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked list published on 13.12.2010 (Category No. 243/2008) for the post.

5. **Method of appointment** : **Direct Recruitment**, (Only from candidates belonging to Latin Catholic /Anglo Indian communities)

**NOTE:** Applications of candidates belonging to communities other than Latin Catholic /Anglo Indian will be summarily rejected. Individual rejection memo will not be sent to them.

6. **Age** : **22 – 43**. Only candidates born between 02.01.1972 and 01.01.1993 (both dates included) are eligible to apply. [For other conditions regarding age relaxations, please see Para 2 of the general conditions of the Gazette notification.]

**7 Qualifications :**

1. Degree of Master of Law with at least 55% marks.
2. Experience at the Bar for a period of not less than 3 years.
3. Must have passed a Comprehensive Test in the concerned subject specifically conducted for the purpose by UGC or any agency duly constituted by the state government in this behalf. When qualifications being equal, preference shall be given to candidates who possess adequate knowledge in Malayalam.

Note: (i) For PhD holders who have passed Master's Degree prior to 19.09.1991, 50% marks for Masters Degree shall be sufficient.

- (ii) Candidates who have obtained Ph.D. Degree in the concerned subject are exempted from passing the NET examination.

- (iii) Experience Certificate as Advocate issued by Bar Council of Kerala or concerned Judicial Officer shall be produced.
- (iv) For recruitment to the above post, Degrees awarded from Universities recognized by UGC alone shall be considered.
- (v) Rule 10 (a) ii of Part II KS & SSR is applicable.

**8. Mode of submitting Applications:-**

Before applying for the post, candidates should register as per “ONE TIME REGISTRATION” Scheme through the Official website of Kerala Public Service Commission [www.keralapsc.gov.in](http://www.keralapsc.gov.in). Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected. Documents to prove qualification, age, community etc have to be produced as and when called for.
