Applications are invited from qualified Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates of Kerala State for selection to the following post. Applications must be submitted online through the official website of the Commission after One Time Registration. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile. The photo uploaded through One Time Registration should be taken after 31.12.2010 and also bear the name of candidate and the date of photo taken should be recorded in the bottom of the photograph. The uploaded photo will be having a validity of ten years from the date of photograph taken.

Note: The above vacancies are now in existence. Recruitment will be made for the above vacancies and also for the vacancies reported for Special Recruitment from Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe during the pendency of the list. Candidates against vacancies exclusively reported for Scheduled Tribes will also be advised from this list and only in the absence of Scheduled Tribe candidates in this list that fresh notification for Scheduled Tribes for vacancies reserved exclusively for them will be issued.

- 5 Method of Appointment** : Direct Recruitment (Special Recruitment from among Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes only).

Note: Applications received from candidates other than Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates will be rejected. Individual communications regarding the rejection of their applications for the above reason will not be issued.

6 Age

: 25-41

Only Candidates born between 02.01.1977 and 01.01.1993 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. No other age relaxation will be allowed.

Note In the absence of qualified candidates within the age limit the upper age limit shall be relaxed up to 50 years. But in no case the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 (Fifty) years

7. Qualifications:

1. A Second Class Master's Degree in Economics/Econometrics/Economic Statistics or Statistics or Agricultural Statistics of a recognised University or Institution.

OR

A Second Class Master's Degree in Mathematics or Commerce of a recognised University or Institution:

Desirable

2. Two years experience in Economics or Statistical Works (theoretical or applied) either in Government Departments or recognised Universities or other recognised Institutions.

Probation: Every person appointed to the post shall from the date on which he joins duty be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years

Note 1) Rule 10(a)(ii) of part II of KS&SSR is applicable.

2) Candidates who claim equivalent qualification instead of qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant Government Order to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification concerned.

3) If the caste of candidates is wrongly mentioned in their SSLC book, they should claim their original caste in their applications and should produce community certificate issued from concerned revenue authority and the Gazette Notification for the same at the time of certificate verification.

4) Experience Certificate shall be produced by the candidates as and

when required by the Commission. The Experience Certificate shall be in the proforma given below:

Candidates shall register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the official
website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying
for the post. Candidates registered can apply by logging on to their profile using
their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of

the respective posts in the Notification Link to applying for a post. No application fee is required. Candidates can view and have a printout of the details in the profile by clicking the link Registration Card. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of each application, the candidates must ensure correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application once submitted is treated as provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove qualification, experience, community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for. The profile correction made by the candidates or in the office of the Kerala Public Service Commission on request after the last date fixed for receipt of application will not be reflected in the application. Such corrections will be in effect on the date on which corrections have been made. Candidates who have Adhar Card should add Aadhar Card as ID proof in their profile.
