(vi) Diploma in Civil Engineering (Two year Course) of the Women's Polytechnic of the State .

(vii) Surveyor Trade Certificate obtained after 18 months course (followed by six months pratical training) at the Industrial Training Institutes or centers conducted by the Government of India, Ministry of Labour.
