Special Recruitment for PH (Locomotor disability/Cerebral palsy, Hearing impairment and Low vision) for filling up of 3% backlog vacancies during 2004-07

(State wide)

Applications must be submitted online through the official website of the Commission after 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION'. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile.

1. **Department** : **Medical Education**

3. **Scale of pay** : **₹ 18740 – 33680/-**
4. **No. of vacancy** : **1 (One) - PH (Reserved to Locomotor disability/Cerebral palsy, Hearing impairment and Low vision)**

The Ranked List prepared in pursuance of this notification is intended to make recruitment to the backlog vacancies earmarked for the various categories and PH groups as per GO (P) No 7/2011/SWD dated 24/01/2011 and will remain in force for a maximum period of three years subject to the condition that the ranked list will cease to exist as and when candidates are advised and appointed against the above mentioned vacancies. Rules 14 to 17 of Part II, KS&SSR are not applicable to this selection.

Candidates will be advised and appointed against the above mentioned vacancies and also against the backlog vacancies, if any, reported by the Appointing Authorities as earmarked in GO(P) No 7/11/SWD dated 24/01/2011.

Selection to the above-mentioned vacancies will be made from among the PH categories found suitable for the post as per existing government orders and vacancies will be apportioned among these categories in the ratio 1:1:1.

5. **Method of Recruitment** : Direct Recruitment through the Public Service Commission from among the qualified Laboratory Technicians in the Medical Education Services belonging to the category of persons with disability → (Direct recruitment from (PH-Locomotor Disability/Cerebral palsy, Hearing Impairment and Low Vision)

In the absence of qualified hands for recruitment from Laboratory Technicians, the vacancy will be filled up from Open Category candidates.(PH)

Note:- Application submitted by candidates other than those belonging to PH (Locomotor disability/Cerebral palsy, Hearing impairment and Low vision) category will be rejected. Individual rejection memo will not be sent to them.

6. **Age** : There will be no upper age limit for 'in-service' candidates.

i). Locomotor disability/Cerebral palsy: 18 – 46: Only candidates born between 02.01.1968 and 01.01.1996 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post

ii) Hearing impairment and Low Vision: 18-50: Only candidate born between 02.01.1964 and 01.01.1996 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.

7. **Qualification** : B.Sc (MLT) from a recognized University

The eligible employees of Medical Education Service, who apply for the above post should obtain the Service Certificate showing the details of service of the applicant which render them eligible to apply for the post and shall be produced when required by the Commission and the certificates thus produced will not be returned to the applicant. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website and notification will be summarily rejected. Documents to prove qualification, age, community etc have to produced as and when called for.
