- (i) In the absence of Scheduled Caste Candidates, Scheduled Tribe candidates will also be considered.
 - (ii) Conventional type applications will be summarily rejected. Candidates shall apply only through online facility available at the Kerala Public Service Commission website viz www.keralapsc.gov.in.
 - (iii) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to these candidates.
 - (iv) Separate Ranked List will be prepared for above districts in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above communities, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following dates in following districts.

- (v) The candidates belonging to above reservation communities shall submit application for this post to the district concerned where the vacancy is in existence for their respective community and shall note the name of that district against the relevant column in the online application.
- (vi) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in GO(Ms) No. 154/71/PD dated, 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to

another district unless he completes five years of continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in GO(MS) No. 4/61/PD dated, 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding the same post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (From candidates belonging to Hindu Nadar and Scheduled Caste communities only).
6. Age limit
- (i) Hindu Nadar: 19-39 Candidates born between 02.01.1975 and 01.01.1995 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.
- (ii) Scheduled Caste. 19-41 Candidates born between 02.01.1973 and 01.01.1995 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.
(including the age relaxation as per Para 2 (i) of General conditions).

Note:- For concessions allowed in upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years, please see para 2 of General Conditions under Part II of this notification.

7. Qualifications :-

- (1) Must have passed SSLC Examination or its equivalent.

Note :- KS&SSR Part II Rule 10 a (ii) is applicable.

- (2) Must not be less than 162 cms in height and 79 cms round the chest and must have a chest expansion of 5 cms on full inspiration.

Note :-

- (i) For candidates belonging to SC/ST, the minimum height prescribed is relaxable by 2.5 cms.
- (ii) Preference will be given to Ex-home Guards within the meaning of G.O (MS) No 50/70/PD dated 12.02.1970.
- (iii) Preference will be given to Ex-Servicemen subject to rules.
- (iv) Women and Physically handicapped persons are not eligible to apply. Hence part (vii) of para 2 and para 5 of general conditions are not applicable to this post.
- (v) NCC cadets having `A', `B', `C' Certificate will be given weightage of marks at the rate of 2%, 3% and 5% respectively vide G.O (MS) No 112/2007/H.Edn dated 21.08.07.

8. **Mode of submitting application:**

Candidates must register as per "ONE TIME REGISTRATION" on the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in'. Those who have registered shall apply by logging on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. No application fee is required. Candidates can view and have a printout of the details on the registration card by clicking the link **Registration Card** after entering the home page. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before applying for a post, candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile and they shall keep in mind the User Id for further communication with the Commission. Application once submitted will be received as provisional and cannot be deleted or altered on after submission. Applications once submitted not in accordance with the conditions of the notification will be summarily rejected. Documents to

prove Qualification, experience, Community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for.

9. Last date of receipt of application: **15.10.2014** Wednesday up to 12 midnight.

10. If a Written Test/OMR Test is conducted as part of the Selection, Admission Tickets of eligible Candidates will be made available in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. Candidates are instructed to download their Admission Tickets as per the instructions in the website.
