2. **Name of Post** : UP School Assistant (Kannada Medium)
3. **Scale of Pay** : Rs. 13,210 – 22,360.
4. **Number of Vacancies** : District Wise

Note:

- (i) A Ranked list will be prepared for Kasaragod district in pursuance of this notification. The Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year subject to the condition that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised for appointment against the aforesaid vacancies and also against the vacancies, if any, reported during the currency of the list. In case no candidate is advised from the ranked list till the expiry of the period of three years, the duration of the ranked list shall be extended for a further period of one year or till at least one candidate is advised from the list whichever is earlier.
- (ii) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O. (Ms) No. 154/71/PD dated 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years

continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O.(Ms)No.4/61/PD dated 02.01.1961. Candidates already in Government Service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

- (iii) Candidates shall submit application for this post to Kasaragod district only and shall note the name of the district against the relevant column in the online application.
- (iv) 3% of vacancies for the post shall be reserved for eligible PH Candidates vide G.O(P)No.11/2009/SWD dated 10/02/09 & GO(P)No.20/98/P&ARD dated 14/07/1998.

5. Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment.

6. Age Limit : 18-40. Only candidates Born between 02.01.1973 and 01.01.1995 (Both dates included) are eligible to apply for the post. Other Backward Communities and SC/ST candidates are eligible for usual age relaxation.

Note:- for concessions regarding upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years, please see para(2) of the General conditions under Para II of this notification.

7. Qualifications:

- (1) A pass in S.S.L.C examination conducted by the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala or its equivalent.

OR

A pass in pre-degree examination conducted by any of the universities in Kerala or any examination recognized by any such universities as equivalent to pre-degree examination.

OR

A pass in Higher Secondary examination conducted by the Board of Higher Secondary Examinations, Kerala or any other examinations recognized by Government as equivalent there to

and

- (2) A pass in TTC (Kannada) Examination conducted by the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala.

OR

A degree in any subject and BEd/BT/LT (Kannada) conferred or recognized by the universities in Kerala.

Special Notes:- (i) In the absence of candidates with TTC (Kannada) of Kerala and BEd.(Kannada) holders from the Universities in Kerala, candidates with TCH (Mysore) shall be considered for appointment.

(ii) Question papers for the Written Test if any, will be in Kannada.

The candidate should answer the questions in Kannada.

8. Special concessions regarding Appointment and age limit.

(i) Preference will be given as laid down in G.O(MS)No.50/70/PD. Dated 12.02.70 and G.O(MS)No.9/78/G.Edn. Dated 21.01.78 to the wives of Jawans in the matter of recruitment as Teachers, if they possess the prescribed qualifications. Soldiers in active service and those working in Base establishment are included under the term 'Jawans'. Wives of jawans should note in the application form that they are "wives of Jawans". Such candidates should obtain proper certificate from the Commanding Officers stating the name, military rank and military address of their husbands and produce the same as and when required by the Commission [G.O(MS)No.509/64/Edn. Dated 19.09.64, G.O(MS)No.614/65/Edn. Dated 09.11.65 and G.O(MS)No.243/66/Edn. Dated 27.05.1966]

(ii) First class Scouts and Guides will be given preference in the matter of appointment as teachers [G.O(MS)No.122/75/G.Edn. Dated 27/05/1975 and G.O.(MS) No.50/70/PD Dated 12.02.1970]

(iii) Laboratory Attenders in the Departmental High Schools in the State who have rendered at least five years satisfactory service and who possess the prescribed qualification will be exempted from the age limit. They should produce proper certificates from the Headmaster of the school specifying the date of commencement of their service and the total service put in by them as and when required by the Commission. The candidates who claim exemption on this basis will be considered only against vacancies to be filled up by open competition on the basis of merit alone (G.O(MS)No.315/62/Edn. Dated 14/05/1962) and will not be given the benefit of communal reservation.

Note:- The candidates who claim concessions on the basis of any of the reason mentioned in the above paras should select “Are you eligible for age relaxation” as 'yes' on the online application and give details in the following space.

9. Last date for receipt of Application:18/12/2013 Wednesday upto 12.00 Midnight.

10. Method of Sending Applications:-

Candidates shall register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION ' system on the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered shall apply by logging in to their profile using their User- ID and password. Candidates shall click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification link to apply for a post. No application fee is required. Candidates can view, and have print-outs of the details in the profile, if required; by clicking on the link **Registration Card**. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before applying for a post, candidates must ensure the correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Applications once submitted will be received as provisional and particulars shall not be deleted or altered after submission. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected. Documents to

prove qualification, age, community, etc. have to be produced as and when called for.
