Applications are invited online only from qualified candidates for appointment in the under mentioned post in Kerala Government Service. Before applying for the post candidates should register as per the One Time Registration through the official website of Kerala Public Service Commission.

1. Department : Industrial Training
2. Name of Post : Junior Instructor (Mechanic Motor Vehicle)
3. Scale of pay : ₹ 13900-24040/-
4. No. of vacancies : 5 (Five)

The above vacancies are now in existence. The list of selected candidates published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies noted above and the vacancies that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the period of currency of the list.

Note:- 3% of vacancies will be reserved for physically handicapped candidates (Locomotor disability/cerebral palsy, Hearing impairment, Low vision) for recruitment to the post as per G.O(P)1/13/SJD dated 03.01.2013.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment
6. Age limit : 19 - 44
Only candidates born between 02.01.1970 and 01.01.1995 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post with usual relaxation to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Communities. (for other conditions regarding the age relaxation please see para 2 of the General Conditions)
7. Qualifications:
 1. S.S.L.C or its equivalent qualification.
And
 2. (a) National Trade Certificate in the appropriate trade with 3 years experience in the trade after obtaining the certificate.
OR
 - (b) National Apprenticeship Certificate in the appropriate trade with one year experience after obtaining the Certificate.
OR

(c) Diploma in the appropriate branch of Engineering from a Government or Government recognized Polytechnic or its equivalent qualification.

1. Rule 10(a)(ii) of Part II of KS & SSR is applicable.
 2. The experience gained by a Workshop Attender can also be deemed to be qualifying experience in the trade for selection to this post.
 3. Candidates belonging to SC/ST are exempted from the qualification of experience prescribed for direct recruitment.
