- ii) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to such candidates.
- iii) Separate Ranked List will be prepared for Malappuram district in pursuance of this notification. The Ranked List thus prepared and published as per the notification shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above community, but remain unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following district.

iv) Reservation community candidates shall submit application for the post to the concerned district officer where the vacancy is existing for their respective community and note the name of that district against the relevant column of the application.

v) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O.(MS)No.154/71/PD, dated 27.5.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O.(Ms)No.4/61/PD, dated 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

5. Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment (from candidates belonging to Latin Catholic Community only)

6. Age limit : 18- 43. Only candidates born between 2.1.1970 and 1.1.1995 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for the post in the case of Latin Catholic (including relaxation in para 2 (i) of the general conditions)

OR

A Pass in Adib-I-Fazil (Preliminary) examination in Urdu conducted by any one of the Universities in Kerala.

OR

A Pass in Urdu Higher Examination conducted by the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala.

Note:- (i) Discipline in which BA/Title of Oriental Learning obtained should be mentioned in the application

(ii) Those candidates who secured BA/Title of Oriental Learning from the Universities outside Kerala should note in the application the number and date of relevant orders recognizing the said degrees. The copies of such order shall be produced before the Commission when it is called for.

8. Special Concessions Regarding Appointment and Age Limit:

(i) Preference will be given as laid down in G.O.(Ms)No.50/70/PD dated 12.02.1970 and G.O.(Ms)No.9/78/G.Edn, dated 21.01.1978 to the wives of Jawans in the matter of recruitment as teachers, if they possess the prescribed qualification. Soldiers in active service and those working in Base establishment are included under the terms of Jawans. Wives of Jawans should select “Are you entitled to any priority as ‘yes’ on online application and give the details in the space following. Such candidates should obtain proper certificates from the officer commanding stating the name, Military rank and Military address of their husbands and produce the same as and when required by the Commission (G.O. (Ms)No.509/64/Edn. Dated 19.09.1964, G.O.(Ms)No.614/65/Edn. Dated 09.11.1965 and G.O (Ms)No.243/66/Edn., dated 27.05.1966).

(ii) First Class Scouts and Guides will be given preference in the matter of appointment as Teachers (G.O.(MS)No.122/75/G.Edn. Dated 27.05.1975 and G.O.(MS)No. 50/70/PD dated 12.02.1970).

(iii)The candidates who claim concessions on the basis of any of the reason mentioned in para 2 of the general conditions should select “Are you eligible for age relaxation” as ‘yes’ on the online application and give details in the space following. Otherwise the applications are eligible to be rejected presuming that they are over aged candidates. Upper age limit after allowing the relaxation as per rule should not exceed 50 years of age. (see para 2 of the General Conditions).

9. Mode of submitting applications

Candidates shall register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' system on the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered shall apply by logging in to their profile using their User – ID and password. Candidates shall click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification link for applying for a post. No application fee is required. Candidates can view and have a print-out of the details in the profile if required by clicking the link Registration Card. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before applying for a post, candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Applications once submitted will be received as provisional and particulars shall not be deleted or altered

after submission. Applications submitted not in accordance with the conditions of the notification will be summarily rejected. Documents to prove Qualification, community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for.
