- (i) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than Scheduled Caste converts to Christianity (SCCC) communities will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to such candidates.
- (ii) The above vacancy is now in existence. The Ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancy earmarked for above community, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published on 26.05.2015 (Cat No.253/2014).
- (iii) In the case of difference in original caste/community claimed in the applications and that entered in SSLC book, the candidate shall produce a gazette notification in this regard along with Noncreamy layer certificate/Caste certificate at the time of certificate verification.

6. Age Limit:

: Direct Recruitment [From candidates belonging to Scheduled caste converts to Christianity(SCCC Only)]. 20 - 34

Only candidates born between 02.01.1985 and 01.01.1999 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. In the case of adult members of SC and their children converted to Christian religion the upper age

limit shall be 36 years ie. candidates born between 02.01.1983 & 01.01.1999

Note Other conditions regarding age relaxation in para 2 of Part II general conditions of the Gazette Notification are not applicable to this selection.

7. Qualifications :

a. Educational Qualification : Graduation

Note 1: *Rule* 10 (*a*) *ii of Part II of KS & SSR is applicable.*

Note 2: Candidates who claim equivalent qualifications instead of qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant government order to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification concerned.

not be accepted. Applications with defective Medical Certificates will be rejected.

- (f) In addition to the qualification prescribed above every candidate will be subjected to a Physical Efficiency Test. The Physical Measurement of the candidates will be taken at the time of Physical Efficiency Test and those who do not possess the prescribed Physical Measurements will not be admitted for the Physical Efficiency Test.

9. Conditions of Service

On selection, the candidates will be under training in the Police Training College for a period of one year. Thereafter they will be on Practical Training for 10 ½ months in the district. The period of training in Police Training College and period of Practical Training in District will not be counted for the purpose of probation, increment and service. On appointment after successful completion of training, the candidates will be on probation for a period of 2 years on duty within a continuous period of 3 years from the date on which they take independent charge of the station. During the period of training in the police training college and practical training in the districts and till successful completion of probationary period the trainee shall be paid such stipend as may be prescribed by the Government for time to time.

As per G.O. (MS) No. 44/85/Home dated 25.02.1985 the Deputy Inspector General of Police is empowered to extend the period of training of the recruits whose performance is found to be unsatisfactory, subject to a maximum of six months in each case. Despite such extension, if the performance of the trainee does not improve, the matter will be brought to the notice of the Inspector General of Police (Head Quarters) and the State Police Chief and if they deem it necessary, will discharge the trainee from training after giving due notice to him/her.

10. Mode of submitting Applications:

Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered shall apply by logging in to their profile using their User- ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification link to apply for a post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken after 31.12.2010. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading of the photograph. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photograph. No application fee is required. Candidates can view the details in their profile by clicking the link Registration Card in their profile. A printout of the same can be taken if needed. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before final submission of the application on the profile, candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the commission. Applications once submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. Applications will be summarily rejected if non compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove Qualification, experience, community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for.

11. Appropriate Disciplinary action as per Rules of procedure Rule 22 shall be initiated against those candidates who submit applications with bogus claims of qualification regarding education, experience etc and submit confirmation for writing examination irrespective of whether they are present or absent for the examination

12. Last date of receipt of Applications: 05.02.2020 Wednesday up to 12.00 midnight.

13. If Written Test/OMR Test/Online Test is conducted as a part of this selection candidate shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration Profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the admission tickets in the last fifteen days till the date of test. The applications of candidate who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of admission tickets will be published in the examination calendar itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone number registered in it. Candidates who have downloaded the Admission Ticket will alone be permitted to attend the examination.
