1st NCA NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited from qualified candidates belonging to following reservation Community of Kerala State for appointment to the under mentioned post. Application must be submitted online through the Official website of the Commission after One Time Registration. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile.

1. Department : **Various**
2. Name of Post : **Sergeant**
3. Scale of pay : **R 22200-48000/-**
4. Number of vacancies : **Districtwise**

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Note:-

- (i) A Ranked List will be prepared for the above district in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancy earmarked for the above community, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following district or for three years from the date of finalization of the NCA Ranked List as per this notification whichever is earlier.

- (ii) The Candidates belonging to above reservation community shall submit application for the post to Wayanad District where the vacancy is existing and shall note the name of that district against the relevant column of the Online application.
- (iii) In the case of change in Community noted in the SSLC book, candidates must claim their original caste/community in the application and shall produce community certificate issued by the Revenue Authorities and the original Gazette notification publishing the change of caste/community at the time of OTR verification for selection to the above post.
- (iv) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in GO(Ms) No. 154/71/PD dated, 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the

Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years of continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in GO(MS) No. 4/61/PD dated, 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding the same post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment-
From candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste community of Kerala State Only).

Note: Application of candidates belonging to the communities other than those belonging to Scheduled Caste community will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to these candidates.

6. Age Limit : **1)Scheduled Caste:**
18 - 41, Only candidates born between 02.01.1978 and 01.01.2001 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. [Including the relaxation as per para 2 (i) of General Conditions].

Note :- For concessions allowed in upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years, please see para (2) of the General Conditions under Part II of this Notification. [Except para 2(i)]

7. **Qualification :**

- (1) Must be a pensioned Junior Commissioned Officer of the Army or equivalent in the Navy or Air Force.

OR

- (2) In the absence of candidates with the qualification mentioned in item (1) above, candidates with literacy in English and ten years Military Service in the Army, Navy or Air Force.

OR

- (3) In the absence of qualified hands under items (1) and (2) above, SSLC or equivalent with six months Police or Military Training.

Note:-

- (i) A working knowledge in Malayalam, or Tamil or Kannada shall be an essential qualification.
- (ii) Differently abled candidates shall not be eligible to apply for the post. Hence sub para vii on Para (2) and Paras 5 & 5 (a) of the General Conditions are not applicable to this post.
- (iii) The candidates shall produce a Medical Certificate from a Medical Officer not below the rank of a Civil Surgeon Grade II to prove the following physical qualification at the time of interview.

(Please see the form of medical certificate given below)

- (a) (i) Height - 167 cms
- (ii) Chest - 81 cms with a minimum expansion of 5 cms. (Minimum height and chest measurement shall be 160 cms and 76 cms respectively for SC/ST candidates. The minimum chest expansion of 5 cms shall however be applicable for them also)

(b) Visual standards with Glasses.

Each eye must have full field of vision. Colour blindness, squint or any morbid condition of the eye or eye lids of either eye shall be a disqualification.

- (c) Must be free from apparent physical defects like knock knee, flat foot, varicose veins, bow legs, deformed limbs, irregular and protruding teeth, defective speech and hearing.
- (iv) KS&SSR Part II Rule 10 a (ii) is applicable for selection to this post.
- (v) Candidates claiming equivalent qualification should produce relevant Government Orders during OTR verification to prove that the qualification claimed is equivalent to the prescribed qualification for the post.

8. **Mode of submitting application:**

Candidates must register as per ONE TIME REGISTRATION with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging in to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the Apply Now button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to applying for a post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken on or after 31/12/2010. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall valid for 10 years from the date of taking the photograph. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link Registration Card in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile, candidates must ensure the correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote their User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The Application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove Qualification, experience, Community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for. **Candidates who have Aadhar Card should add Aadhar Card as ID proof in their profile.**
