- (iii)In the case of change in caste noted in the SSLC book, candidate must claim their original caste in the application and shall produce Non Creamy Layer Certificate issued by the Revenue authorities and the gazette notification publishing the change of caste at the time of OTR verification for selection to the above post.
- (iv) The Forth NCA Notification is issued due to the paucity of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste Converted to Christianity (SCCC)community after the issuance of the First NCA notification vide Category Number 290/15, Second NCA Notification vide Category Number 460/17 and Third NCA Notification vide Category Number 228/18

- (v) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O (MS) No. 154/71/PD dated 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O (MS) No.4/61/PD dated 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government Service holding the same post in this Department in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

2. Ayurveda Colleges

19-39. ie Candidates born between 02.01.1980 and 01.01.2000 (both dates included) are only eligible to apply for this post. (Including the relaxation as per para 2(i) of the General Conditions).

In the case of candidates belonging to Adult members of Scheduled Caste and their children when such adult members are converted to Christianity the upper age limit will be 41 years. ie such candidates should be born between 02.01.1978 and 01.01.2000 (both dates included). - (ii) Diploma/Certificate in Ayurveda pharmacist course recognised by the Government of Kerala.

Certificate of Ayurveda Pharmacist Course recognised by the Government.

Note:- KS&SSR Part II Rule 10 a(ii) is applicable for selection to this post. Candidate claiming equivalent qualification should produce relevant Government Orders during verification to prove that the qualification claimed is equivalent to the prescribed qualification for the post.

8. Mode of submitting Applications:-

Candidates must register as per "ONE TIME REGISTRATION" with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission, viz, 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the `Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken after 31/12/2010. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of taking the photograph. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link Registration Card in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile, candidates must ensure the correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote their User-ID for further communication with the Commission. **Application** submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The Application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing.
