- Note:- (i) Seperate Ranked list will be prepared for Kannur District in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission, shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year, subject to the condition that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of new lists after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised against the aforesaid vacancy and also against the vacancies, if any, reported during the currency of the lists. In case no candidate is advised from the ranked list till the expiry of the period of three years, the duration of the Ranked list shall be extended for a further period of one year or till at least one candidate is advised from the list whichever is earlier.
 - (ii) Candidates should submit application for this post to the concerned District Office and should note the name of concerned District against the relevant column of the Online Application.
 - (iii) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in GO(MS)No.154/71/PD dated 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she complete 5 years continues service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G O (Ms)No. 4/61/PD dated 02.01.1961.Candidates already in Government Service holding the post in any one districts are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.
 - (iv) In the case of change in Caste noted in the SSLC book, candidates must claim their original Caste in the application and shall produce Caste

Certificate / Non-creamy Layer certificate issued by the Revenue authorities and the Gazette Notification publishing the change of Caste at the time of OTR verification for selection to the above post.

- **6.** Age Limit
- :- 19-36. Only candidates born between 2.1.1983 and 1.1.2000 (both dates are included) are eligible to apply for this post with usual relaxation to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Communities.

7. Qualifications:-

- (1) Pass in P.D.C in Science Group or any other equivalent qualification recognised by Govt. of Kerala.
- (2) Pass in Medical Laboratory Technology Course conducted in the Medical Colleges of Kerala or any other equivalent qualification.

Note :- KS&SSR Part II Rule 10 a (ii)is applicable for selection to this post.

Candidates claiming equivalent qualification should produce relevant Government Orders during verification to prove that the qualification claimed is equivalent to the prescribed qualification for the post.

8. Mode of submitting Applications :-

Candidates shall register as per ONE TIME REGISTRATION with the official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the Apply Now button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The Photograph uploaded should be taken on or after 31.12.2010. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of taking the Photograph. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link Registration Card in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and

secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove qualification, age, Community etc. have to be produced as and when called for. Candidates who have AADHAAR card should add AADHAAR Card as I.D Proof in their profile

- 10. If written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, candidate shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration Profile. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of admission tickets will be published in the Examination calendar itself.
