Applications are invited online only from qualified candidates for selection to the undermentioned post in Kerala Government Service. Applications must be submitted online only through the official website of the Kerala Public Service Commission after "ONE TIME REGISTRATION".

- 1 Department : Medical Education**
- 2 Name of Post : Mortuary Technician Grade - II**
- 3 Scale of pay : Rs. 22,200-48,000/-**
- 4 Number of vacancies : 01(One)**

The above vacancy is now in existence. The Ranked list published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the period of currency of the list.

5 Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment

6 Age limit : 18-36; [Only candidates born between **02.01.1984** and **01.01.2002** (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post with usual relaxation to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Communities].
(For other conditions regarding the age relaxation please see Part II, Para 2 of the General Conditions of the Gazette notification.)

7 Qualifications :

- a) Pass in PDC in Science of a recognized University/Board or its equivalent qualification.
- b) A pass in MLT (Medical Lab Technology) conducted in the Medical Colleges in Kerala or equivalent qualification.

Note (a) : Candidates who claim equivalent qualifications instead of qualification mentioned in the Notification shall produce the relevant Government Order to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification concerned.

Note (b) : In the case of difference in original Caste/Community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC book, the candidate shall produce a

Gazette notification in this regard, along with Non Creamy Layer Certificate/Community Certificate at the time of certificate verification

Note (c) : Rule 10(a)ii of Part II KS & SSR is applicable

8. Mode of submitting Application:-

(a) Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the '**Apply Now**' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The Photograph uploaded should be taken after 31.12.2010. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link **Registration Card** in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile, candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove qualification, age, Community etc. have to be produced as and when called for.

(b) If written/OMR/Online is conducted Test as part of this selection candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration Profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period, will be rejected absolutely. Appropriate disciplinary action as per Rules of Procedure Rule 22 shall be initiated against those candidates who submit applications with bogus claims of qualification regarding education, experience etc. and submit confirmation for writing examination, irrespective of whether they are present or absent for the examination. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Calendar itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone number registered in it.

(c) Candidates who have AADHAAR card should add AADHAAR Card as I.D Proof in their profile.
