INCA- NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited online only through **One Time Registration scheme** from qualified candidates belonging to the Dheevera Community of Kerala State against NCA vacancies for selection to the under mentioned post in Kerala Government service. Applications must be submitted online through the official website of the Commission after One Time Registration . Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile.

- 1. Department** : **Animal Husbandry**
- 2. Name of Post** : **Veterinary Surgeon Gr II**
- 3. Scale of pay** : **₹ 39500 - 83000/-**
- 4. Number of vacancies** : **Dheevera-01(One)**

The above vacancy is now in existence. The Ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for Dheevera community as unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published on 14.12.2017(Cat. No: 279/2016, Gazette date : 29.09.2016) for the post.

Note:- As per GO(P)No.61/2012/SWD dated 17.10.2012 differently abled candidates with only Locomotor Disability/Cerebral Palsy are identified as suitable for appointment to the post of Veterinary Surgeon in Animal Husbandry Department . Hence differently abled candidates with Blindness/Low vision & Hearing Impairment are not eligible to apply for this post.

- 5. Method of appointment** : Direct Recruitment (From among candidates belonging to Dheevera community only)

Note:- Applications submitted by candidates other than the community mentioned above will be rejected. No individual rejection memo will be issued to such candidates.

- 6. Age limit** : **18-42.** Only candidates born between 02.01.1979 and 01.01.2003 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for the post.(including the relaxation as per Para 2(i) of the General Conditions)
[For other conditions regarding age relaxations please see Para (2) of the General Conditions except Para 2(i)]

7. Qualifications

1. Degree in Veterinary Science .
2. Registration with the Kerala State Veterinary Council as envisaged in the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 (Central Act of 52 of 1984).
3. Working knowledge in Malayalam.

Note :-

- 1 Relaxation from the above qualification under item 3 shall be allowed to persons belonging to Linguistic Minorities in the State subject to the condition that they shall pass the Language Test in Malayalam as provided in clause (aaaa) of Rule 10 of Part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958.
- 2 Working knowledge in Malayalam will be assessed by the Commission during the course of selection.
- 3 KS & SSR Part II Rule 10(a)(ii) is applicable.
- 4 Candidates who claim equivalent qualifications instead of the qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant Equivalency Certificate (in case if equivalency is mentioned in the Notification)/ Government Order to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification concerned.
- 5 In the case of difference in original caste/community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC book, the candidates shall produce a Gazette notification in this regard, along with Non Creamy Layer Certificate/Community Certificate at the time of Certificate Verification.

Training

- 1 Candidates on appointment as Veterinary Surgeon Gr II shall undergo within the period of probation, the training course conducted by the Animal Husbandry Department and the period of such training shall be treated as duty for the purpose of probation.
- 2 Persons in the Animal Husbandry Subordinate Service who have worked as Livestock Assistants for a period of not less than 5 years and personnel released from the army who are appointed in reserved vacancies will be exempted from undergoing the training.
- 3 Persons who have undergone the B.VSc and Animal Husbandry course with an inbuilt programme of internship training conducted by the Kerala

Agricultural University or any other Agricultural University shall be exempted from undergoing the training.

8. **Mode of Submitting applications:**

- (a) Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by log in on to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the '**Apply Now**' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for the post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken after 31.12.2011 . Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. **Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the print out of the application by clicking on the link 'My applications' in their profile. All correspondence with the Commission, regarding the application should be accompanied with the print out of the application.** The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Original Documents to prove qualification, experience, age, Community etc. have to be produced as and when called for.
- (b) If written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration Profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period, will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Calendar itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone number registered in it.
- (c) (c) Appropriate disciplinary action as per **Rules of Procedure Rule 22** shall be initiated against those candidates who submit applications with bogus claims of qualification regarding education, experience etc. and submit

confirmation for writing the examination, irrespective of whether they are present or absent for the examination.

(d) Candidates who have AADHAAR card should add AADHAAR Card as I.D Proof in their profile.
