- Note:- i) The above Vacancy is now in existence. The Ranked list of selected candidates published by the Commission shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years provided that the said list will not continue to be in force if a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year is published for this post under the same method of appointment. Advices for appointment will be made for the above vacancies and also for the vacancies reported for Special Recruitment from Scheduled Tribe during the pendency of the list.
 - <u>ii</u> The name of the post, qualification and related conditions for selection is notified as per the provisions included in G.O(P)No.89/2014/Home dated 06.05.2014 and GO(P)No.266/2010/Home dated 09.12.2010.
 - (a) Every person appointed to the post shall from the date on which she joins duty be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

(b) They shall undergo in-service training as prescribed by the Head of Department.

(c) They shall pass Kerala Jail Subordinate Officers test within the period of probation unless they have already passed the test.

(d) Statewise Seniority List will be maintained on the warder establishment for the purpose of promotion to other categories.

- 6 Age

Only Candidates born between 02.01.1982 and 01.01.2005 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.

Note:- In the absence of qualified candidates within the age limit, the upper age limit shall be relaxed upto 50 years. But in no case the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 (fifty) years.

7 Qualifications

- 1. Pass in S.S.L.C or its equivalent qualification.
- Note:- i) Part II Rule 10(a)ii of KS&SSR regarding qualification is applicable for this selection.

ii) In addition to the qualifications prescribed in the notification, the qualifications recognized by Executive Orders or Standing Orders of Government as equivalent to a qualification specified for a post, in the Special Rules or found acceptable by the Commission in cases where acceptance of equivalent qualifications is provided for in the rules and such of those qualifications which pre-suppose the acquisition of the lower qualification prescribed for the post, shall also be sufficient for the post. The copy of the Government orders declaring equivalent / higher qualifications shall be produced as and when required by the Commission.

efficiency test. If accidents or injuries happened to candidate while participating in the Physical Efficiency Test, she will not be given further chance to participate in the test. The candidates should produce at the time of Physical Efficiency Test, a Medical Certificate in original in the form prescribed hereunder certifying to their physical fitness and eye sight without glasses.
