Applications are invited from qualified candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste Converted to Christianity Community of Kerala State for appointment to the under mentioned post. Application must be submitted online through the official website of the Commission after One Time Registration. Applications submitted in any other manner will be summarily rejected.

1. Department : **Health Services**
2. Name of Post : **Field Worker**
3. Scale of pay : **₹23700-52600/-**
4. No. of vacancies : District wise
Alappuzha - Scheduled Caste Converted to Christianity (SCCC) - 01 (one)

Note:- (i) A Ranked List will be prepared for Alappuzha district for the above community in pursuance of this notification. The Ranked list thus prepared and published by the Commission as per this notification shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the Vacancy earmarked for the above Community, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates till date from the Ranked List published for the Post in the following District.

- (ii) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be subject to the rules amended as per GO(P) No.12/2016/P&ARD dated 04.06.2016
- (iii) The Candidates belonging to the above reservation community shall submit application for this post to Alappuzha District where the Vacancy is existing and shall note the name of that district against the relevant column in the online application.
- (iv) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O.(MS) No. 154/71/PD dated 27/5/1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the ranked list prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years continuous service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rule in G.O (P)No.36/91/P&ARD dated 02.12.1991. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (From candidates belonging to SCCC Community of Kerala State Only)

Note:- Application submitted by candidates belonging to the community other than those belonging to Scheduled Caste Converted to Christianity (SCCC) Community will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to these candidates.

6. Age Limit : 18-39. Only candidates born between 02.01.1984 and 01.01.2005 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. [Including the relaxation as per para 2 (i) of General Conditions].

- Note:-
- (i) *In the case of Adult members of the Scheduled Caste and their children when such adult members are converted to Christianity the age limit will be 18-41, ie Such candidates should be born between 02.01.1982 and 01.01.2005 (both dates included). (including the relaxation as per Para 2(i) of the General Conditions)*
 - (ii) *For concessions allowed in upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 (fifty) years of age, please see para (2) of General Conditions under part II of this Notification.*

- 7 Qualifications:
- 1) Should have passed Standard VII and should not have acquired Graduation.
 - 2) Should have good physique and must be free from physical deformity and diseases of any description.

Note:-

(1) Physical fitness certificate obtained from a Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon shall be produced. Candidates should produce a Medical Fitness Certificate from a Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon (in the prescribed form) when called for by the Commission. Form of Medical Fitness Certificate is given below.

Note: Certificate should be one issued by a Medical Officer in Govt. Service **not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon.**

(2) Differently Abled persons are not eligible to apply for the post.

(3) Concessions for Differently Abled candidates contemplated in para 2 and 5 of the General Condition are not applicable for selection to this post.

(4) In addition to the qualifications prescribed in the notification, the qualifications recognized by executive orders or standing orders of government as equivalent to a qualification specified for the post, in the Special Rules and such of those qualifications which pre-suppose the acquisition of the lower qualification prescribed for the post, shall also be sufficient for the post. The copy of the government orders declaring equivalent /higher qualifications shall be produced as and when required by the Commission.

(5) Rule 10a(ii) of the Part II of KS&SSR will be applicable for this post.

8 Mode of submitting Applications:-

- (a) Candidates must register as per One Time registration scheme through the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have already registered can apply by logging in to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the Apply Now button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for the post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken on or after **31/12/2013. Candidate who have created new profile should upload their photograph taken within a period of 6 months.** Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements

shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of application on the profile, candidates must ensure the correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote their User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the print out of the application by clicking on the link **My Applications** in their profile. All correspondence with the commission regarding the application should be accompanied with the print out of the application. The Application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove Qualification, Experience, Community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for.

- (b) If Written Test /OMR/ Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Programme itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phones registered in it. Candidates who have downloaded the Admission Ticket will alone be permitted to attend the examination. As per Rule 22 of the KPSC Rules of Procedure 1976, appropriate disciplinary action will be taken against those candidates who submit application for the post with false claims of possession of prescribed qualification experience and give confirmation for examination, irrespective of the fact that they have appeared or not for the examination.
- (c) **Candidates who have Aadhar Card should add Aadhar Card as ID proof in their profile**

11 Special Instructions to candidates

- (a) In the case of difference in Caste/Community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC Book, the candidate shall produce a Gazette notification in this regard, along with Non Creamy Layer Certificate /Community Certificate at the time of certificate verification.
- (b) Candidates are required to acquaint themselves within the instructions given in the notifications as part II, General Conditions before submitting application for the post. Applications which are not submitted in accordance with the terms and conditions laid down in the General Conditions are liable to be rejected.
- (c) Appropriate disciplinary action as per Rule 22 of the Kerala Public Service Commission Rules of Procedure 1976 shall be initiated against those candidates who submit applications with bogus claims of qualification regarding education, experience etc. and are liable to be disqualified for being considered for a particular post or debarment from applying to the Commission either permanently or for any period or the invalidation of their answer scripts or products in a written / practical test or the initiation of criminal or other proceedings against them or their removal or dismissal from office or the ordering of any other disciplinary action against them if they have already been appointed, or any one or more of the above.
