- (i) Conventional type applications will be summarily rejected. Candidates shall apply only through online facility available at the Kerala Public Service Commission website viz www.keralapsc.gov.in.
- (ii) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than Scheduled Tribe community will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to these candidates.
- (iii) A Ranked List will be prepared for Kannur District in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above community, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following date in Kannur district.

(iv) The candidates belonging to above reservation community shall submit application for this post to the above district where the vacancy is in existence for their respective community and shall note the name of that district against the relevant column in the online application.

- (v) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G O (MS) No. 154/71/PD dated 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subjected to the rules in G O (MS) No.4/61/PD, dated 2.1.1961. But as per the G.O.(P) No. 12/96/ P & ARD dtd. 16.03.1996 the condition of 5 years service is not applicable for transfer to the Districts of Idukki, Wayanad and Kasargod. This concession will be available only for getting transfer into these Districts but not for getting transfer out of these Districts. Candidates already in Government Service holding the same post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.
- 5. Method of appointment :- Direct Recruitment (From candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes Community only).
- 5. Age Limit :- 19-41 Scheduled Tribe Candidates born between 02.01.1974 and 01.01.1996 (both dates included) are only eligible to apply for this post. (Including the relaxation as per para 2 (i) of the General conditions)

7. Qualifications:-

A computer certificate ABC of the Indian Statistical Institute, Calcutta.

- Note:-(1) 60% marks in Mathematics in SSLC will not be insisted upon in the case of Last Grade servants employed in the Economics and statistics Department and in the case of Graduates in Mathematics, Economics, Statistics or Commerce.
 - (2) Candidates should note the percentage of marks secured for Mathematics in the SSLC examination. Candidates who do not possess 60% marks in Mathematics for SSLC and who possess degree in Economics, Mathematics, Statistics or Commerce must note in the application the subject of the degree possessed in brackets.

Note:- KS&SSR Part II Rule 10 a(ii) is applicable for selection to this post.

8. Mode of submitting Applications:-

Candidates must register as per "ONE TIME REGISTRATION" with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging in to their profile using their User-ID and password.
