7. Qualifications

I or II Class Masters Degree in Mridangam or its equivalent from any statutory University / "University and Deemed Universities recognized by the UGC".

Note

- 1) Candidates who are Ph.D holders require only 50% marks for Masters Degree if they have acquired the respective Masters Degree prior to 19th September 1991
- 2) For the post of Lecturer when the qualifications are equal preference shall be given to those who have studied Malayalam as one of the languages either at Degree level or Post Graduate level.
